ESTABLISHED BY THE SUGAR RESEARCH FOUNDATION TO SEPTEMBER 6, 1945

THE FOUNDATION'S first project was to create at the Massachus Institute of Technology, Cambridge, Massachusetts, The Sugar Resea Foundation Laboratory. This laboratory was established for five years an appropriation of \$125,000. It provides students of broad fundament scientific training with an opportunity to specialize in the chemistry of sugars.

Towards this end courses in carbohydrate chemistry are given an research program is maintained by a staff of full-time post-doctoral Research Associates and pre-doctoral Research Assistants, a program with which didates for degrees may become associated as fellows or part-time assista

The program is under the general supervision of the Scientific Dire in close collaboration with the Institute's Department of Chemistry. *Tresearch is not related to sugar production*, but is directed toward fur mental and exploratory studies of the kind from which new uses of su as a chemical material may ultimately develop.
